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## RESOLUTION NO. SBOB/2012-20

A RESOLUTION OF THE OVERSIGHT BOARD FOR THE SUCCESSOR AGENCY TO THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SAN BERNARDINO DIRECTING THE SUCCESSOR AGENCY TO TAKE ALL NECESSARY ACTION TO RECOVER APNS 0281-021-30, 0281-031-51, 0281-031-52 and 0281-041-41 AND ANY LEASES OR AGREEMENTS RELATING THERETO; AND AFFIRMING THE OVERSIGHT BOARD'S SUPPORT FOR TRANSFERRING EASEMENTS OVER A PORTION OF SAID PROPERTY TO THE SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY FLOOD CONTROL DISTRICT FOR ACCESS AND MAINTENANCE OF FLOOD CONTROL FACILITIES AND COMMON USE AS A PORTION OF THE REGIONAL RECREATIONAL SANTA ANA RIVER TRAIL

WHEREAS, the California state legislature enacted Assembly Bill x1 26 (the "Dissolution Act") to dissolve redevelopment agencies formed under the Community Redevelopment Law (Health and Safety Code Section 33000 et seq.); and

WHEREAS, on January 9, 2012 and pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 34173, the Mayor and Common Council of the City of San Bernardino (the "City Council") adopted Resolution No. 2012-12 confirming that the City of San Bernardino, a charter city (the "City"), would act as successor agency (the "Successor Agency") for the dissolved Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Bernardino (the "RDA") effective February 1, 2012; and

WHEREAS, on February 1, 2012, the RDA was dissolved pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 34172; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to AB 1484 ("AB 1484"), enacted June 27, 2012 to amend various provisions of the Dissolution Act, the Successor Agency is now declared to be a separate legal entity from the City; and

WHEREAS, the Dissolution Act provides for the appointment of an oversight board (the "Oversight Board") with specific duties to approve certain Successor Agency actions pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 34180 and to direct the Successor Agency in certain other actions pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 34181; and

WHEREAS, by quitclaim deed dated March 17, 2011, the RDA transferred to the San Bernardino Economic Development Corporation ("SBEDC"), a California nonprofit

corporation. Parcel No. 5 and Parcel No. 6 of Parcel Map No. 4781, in the City of San Bernardino, County of San Bernardino, State of California, as per plat recorded in Book 48 of Parcel Maps, page 87, inclusive, records of said County; assessor parcel numbers 0281-021-30, 0281-031-51, 0281-031-52 and 0281-041-41 (the "Property"); and

such transfers by redevelopment agencies to economic WHEREAS, development corporations are subject to the "claw back" provisions of the Dissolution Act; and

WHEREAS, the City was instrumental in establishing the SBEDC, the Mayor of the City is the President of the SBEDC and the RDA's former Executive Director is the Chief Executive Officer of SBEDC; and

WHEREAS, portions of the Property are adjacent to the Santa Ana River streambed which is maintained by the San Bernardino County Flood Control District (the "Flood Control District"); and

WHEREAS, due to the location, portions of the Property are undevelopable for economic activity and thus, of no commercial value; and

WHEREAS, obtaining easements over portions of the Property would provide easier and greater access to the Flood Control District for maintenance of flood control facilities for the protection of life and property; and

WHEREAS, in 1955 the Santa Ana River Corridor was recommended to the California State Parks Commission as a multi use recreation area; and

WHEREAS, thirty five years later in 1990, a master plan for trail and recreational development along the Santa Ana River was completed and Orange and Riverside Counties started to develop the Santa Ana River Trail (SART) with San Bernardino County subsequently participating; and

WHEREAS, the passage of the 2000 Parks Bond Act (Prop 12) and the 2002 Resources Bond Act (Prop 40) provided funding for trail development; and

WHEREAS, two of four phases of SART trail development have been completed; and

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WHEREAS, SART is now a regionally significant recreational facility traversing three counties and providing recreational opportunities for millions of residents; and

WHEREAS, the commencement of Phase 3 of SART is dependent on obtaining rights-of-way over the 3.6 mile reach from Waterman Avenue in San Bernardino to California Street in the City of Redlands, including rights-of-way over portions of the Property; and

WHEREAS, delays in obtaining the necessary rights-of-way will initially place \$559,000 of grant funding at risk and could lead to significantly larger funding losses; and

WHEREAS, the recovery from the SBEDC of the Property by the Successor Agency will enable the Successor Agency to expeditiously evaluate and act on the disposition of easements for significant public good;

WHEREAS, the accompanying staff report provides supporting information upon which the action set forth in this Resolution is based.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Oversight Board hereby finds, resolves, and determines that the foregoing recitals are true and correct, and, together with information provided by the Successor Agency staff and the public, form the basis for the findings, resolutions, and determinations set forth below.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Oversight Board directs the Successor Agency to take any and all necessary actions to recover the Property and any related leases or other agreements from the SBEDC without delay.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Oversight Board hereby affirms its support for transferring easements over a portion of the Property to the San Bernardino County Flood Control District for access and maintenance of flood control facilities and common use as a portion of the regional recreational Santa Ana River Trail.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall take effect from and after its date of adoption by this Board.
